LOCAL LAW # 1 OF 2023 TOWN OF PRATTSVILLE DISABLED AND LOW INCOME CITIZEN REAL PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS

Be it enacted by the Town of Prattsville as follows:

Section 1. Title

This Local Law shall be known as "A Local Law Establishing Income Levels for Real Property Taxes for Disabled and Low Income Citizens."

Section 2. Authorization

This local law is enacted pursuant to the requirements set forth in the New York State Real Property Tax Law §459-c to establish real property tax income levels for disabled and low income citizens.

Section 3. Exemption Levels

The Town of Prattsville hereby adopts as the maximum level of income for persons eligible for the within exemption as \$34,000.00 (Thirty Four Thousand Dollars). The "sliding scale" provisions of New York Real Property Tax Law §459(c) are also hereby adopted.

Section 4. Repealer

Any prior local law currently in existence which is inconsistent with the terms of this local law is hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective

This Local Law shall take effect immediately in accordance with the requirements of the New York State Municipal Home Rule Law
